



## Kathryn Marie Wallace

Kathryn Marie Wallace, aged 82, died peacefully with family by her side on June 14, 2016 after a long illness. Kathryn was born June 12, 1934 in Utica, New York, the daughter of James and Lila Doherty.

Kathryn grew up in Syracuse and New Hartford, New York and graduated from Utica Catholic Academy High School - Class of 1953.
