Ken passed away peacefully on December 31, 2014. He was born in Bridgeport, Connecticut April 16, 1914. His father was Ernest Brown and mother Jenny Lind. Ken had a sister Pat and brother Chester. He married Betty Sliwa in 1941 in Fall River, Massachusetts. Betty passed away in 1996.

Dad married Mattie Lewis in 1997. Mattie has been in a nursing home in Oxford Mississippi since 2008.

Ken and Betty had three children, Kenneth (Sylvia), Peter (Gigi) (Peter died 2001) and Stephen (died 1999).

In 1962, after their children were gone, Ken and Betty sold their home in Tiverton, RI and moved to Daytona Beach, FL. In Daytona Ken worked for GE

until his retirement in 1976. At GE he built custom machined parts for the Apollo program.
