JSK, Jai Swaminarayan,

It is with great sorrow i write this, yet with a heart filled with completion and peace.

Bhabhi (my cousin late VM Patel's wife - My Foi's Son who was also raised in his younger days by my Dad in East Africa), was one of the most humble down to earth persons i know even during her hay days of being in the limelight of the multi millionaire lifestyle. She was the true Rock of the family. That was her true quality in relationships and pure humanity values. She was always happy and content with the simplest of foods and lifestyle even though she was surrounded by some of the wealthiest entrepreneurs in UK during the 70's and 80's. Having stayed with the family for a good 18 months in the last 70s, and seeing the kids grow up, I will always cherish those respectful moments. Just last year after numerous regular calls on video, something came over me and I cancelled all meetings/conferences and trips to India , china etc. and decided to pay Bhabhi a visit in January last minute, after nearly 18? years, as she just sounded very down than the usual and always asked me to visit. Fate pulled me there to have such precious moments together and again be a coach to the family. After nearly 3 weeks spending quality time with Bhabhi, Jayesh, Niraj and his kids, we had some great catchup and daily cooking together, but most importantly this quality time with Bhabhi with deep conversations on past, present and future. I will cherish those forever, not knowing those would be my final face to face conversations. On my return back to Bucharest, these regular calls and video chats increased to weekly if not twice/three times a week sometimes just to checkup on matters. With Covid-19 lockdown, I constantly talked to bhabhi and the kids to be careful of contact with her from outside regarding the Covid-19 infection, not knowing her life would be taken away from her from the other illness. Having Trush there during her last days i feel she was truly at peace with the whole family close to her in her final moments.

Whenever I even hear of certain foods now for life it will remind me of her, no matter what. Her specialities were Dhokra, Khamni, daal dogri and pillau rice. I really dont think i will eat these soon due to our fond memories even though I used to tease her with these foods in a fond way.

I will truely miss our chats and jokes.
