A few years ago, my family hosted an AFS student from Thailand and, while this was an extraordinary experience, it was not always that easy ... I then wrote to Letty to tell her that I was realizing how difficult it must have been for them to have me in their family for so long.

Her wonderful reply was simply that she only remembered the good times ! (and certainly did not recall when I had used their phone or -

tried to- grow a beard against all the house rules !)

I will always cherish my time with the Scherr family

It has been an extraordinary phase of my life which has brought me so much

I was very happy to be able to visit Letty a couple of times since 1975 and more recently i was grateful for Debbie who organized for us to chat by Zoom

Letty (Mom) will remain forever in my heart, together with Daniel (Dad) and of course my brother David

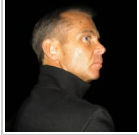
