The Family of Lissette Martinez, is grateful to you for your Prayers, Thoughts and helping us bear our grief by your kindness and sympathy, you expressed

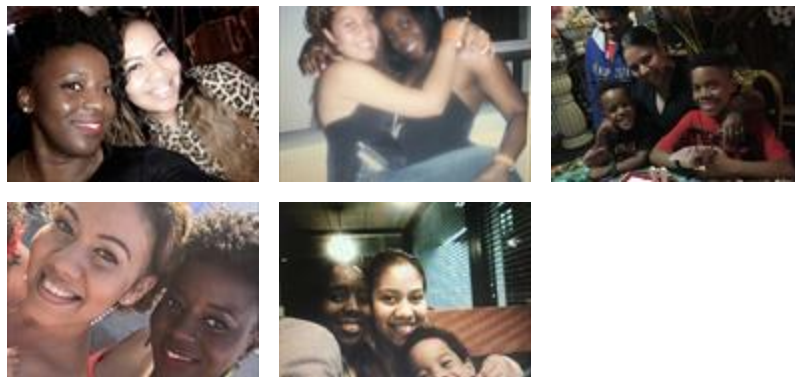
to us. Our lives together have been pure, Blessed, and so happy together.
