Lloyd William (Bill) Chamberlin III went to be with the Lord on June 16, 2023. Born in Thomasville Georgia on December 2, 1943 into a military family he spent his early years based at his ancestral home in Monticello Florida with frequent moves around the country ultimately graduating high school in Virginia.

He graduated from Florida State University in 1965 with a degree in Business and was a proud member of Sigma Chi Fraternity. Upon graduation, he was commissioned into the US Air Force, having a brief career in military communications. Following his stint in the military, Bill had a 30-year career at GTE (Verizon) primarily in Tampa with some of his proudest achievements coming during his time as Director of Labor Relations.
