



Louis Ignacio Gaby

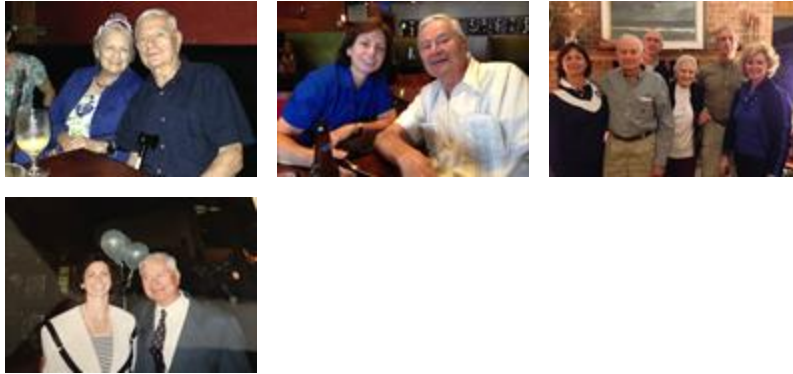
June 23, 1927 - November 2, 2019
