Lyman was born on March 14, 1927 to William and Mary Jane (Baxter) Sosbey in Indianapolis, Indiana. He graduated from Warren Central High School and served in Germany in the Army Air Corps from 1945-1947. Lyman married his high school sweetheart, Marylou Peters, on Easter Sunday, April 6, 1947, and they celebrated their 65th wedding anniversary this year.

Lyman worked on the Monon Railroad for 45 years. His dream to retire to Florida was fulfilled in 1986.
