Marianna Victoria (Wolf) Pasciuto passed away peacefully the morning of August 31, 2020, at the age of 82 with her children by her side at Cornerstone Hospice in Ocoee, FL. Better known as Mary, she was preceded in death by her husband, Donato Michael Pasciuto (1926-2015) and her brother, George Wolf (1936-2019).
