Anne Marie Ambrosine Glasse, 71, died March 15, 2012, at her home in Orlando, Florida surrounded by her children, family and friends.

Anne Marie was born December 7, 1940 in Castries, St Lucia, a beautiful island in the Eastern Caribbean Sea. Even as a youth she was a devout Catholic. She was an active member of the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception where she enjoyed singing as a member of the choir. As she was very fond of children and education, she began an early career in teaching at the age of 16 in St. Lucia. She then came to the United States in 1958.

Anne Marie's professional career started as an Administrative Secretary with HIP of New Jersey/HCP of New Jersey for seven years, and then as a Medical Secretary and Office Manager for Mid Florida Surgery Center during her five years employment, and most recently as Support Personnel to both the Audit and Evaluation and the Families Parks and Recreation Departments with the City of Orlando for a total of eleven years.

For the past 25 years, Anne Marie has been a devout member of St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Church. Her community involvement included several committees at St. Charles Borromeo Catholic Church to include Minister of Holy Communion, Sacristan Committee, Minister of the Bereavement Committee and a Member of the Council of Catholic Women. As well, she was

active in the community at large. Anne Marie's altruistic activities lead her to volunteer at Edgewater High School for five years and to be involved with many other civic activities during her years in the Orlando community.

Anne Marie's personal interests include reading, traveling worldwide, singing, writing, cooking and baking and entertaining at her home for any celebratory occasion. She also enjoyed attending the Opera and Theatre.

Mrs. Glasse is survived by her husband of 50 years Mr. Gregory Glasse; her four children, Greg, Leslie, Monique, and Fortune; a daughter-in-law, Sheila; two sons-in-law, Kevin and Cassidy; and her three grandchildren, Jessica, Aria, and Zachary. Mrs. Glasse is also survived by six brothers and sisters, Elizabeth, Leonie, Stephanie, Fitzgerald, Michael, and Helene; and a host of nieces, nephews and other family, friends and loved ones. She was preceded in death by one brother, Maximus.

Anne Marie will be laid to rest at the Saint Charles Cemetery in Farmingdale, New York on March 24, 2012.
