Mrs. Marjorie (Moulton) Fallon of Winter Park passed away peacefully on Thursday, February 23rd, 2017. She was 89 years old.

Born in Malden, Mass., she is the daughter of the late David and Evelyn Moulton. She was raised in Melrose, MA and attended Melrose High School graduating in 1947. She was a member of the Lincoln School, Cloak and Plume, Varsity Field Hockey, Basketball and Softball teams.
