Marjorie Smith Pryde, 88, formerly of Sarasota, died at Allegro at College Harbor on August 26th after a brief illness. A resident of Sarasota since 1970, she studied painting at the Ringling School of Art in Sarasota, and exhibited her paintings and sculpture at the Buyways Gallery on Siesta Key in Sarasota for a number of years, in addition to buying and selling antique jewelry and operating an estate sales business.

She was born in East St. Louis, Illinois, graduated from high school in Belleville, IL, and attended Stephens College, Columbia, Mo. She married Ralph W. Smith, who owned a St. Louis advertising agency in 1940. Following his death in 1981 she married Richard Pryde of Toronto, Ontario, who also preceded her in death.

Mrs. Smith Pryde moved to St. Petersburg in 2001 in order to be in closer proximity to two sons, St. Pete businessmen Stephen T. Smith and Brian K. Smith and their respective children and grandchildren. Her eldest son, Neal R. Smith lives in Denver, CO.
