His friendships were meaningful and he was always quick to lend a helping hand. Whatever the invitation, he always accepted with enthusiasm and looked forward to the occasion. Above all, Mark cherished his family and nothing fulfilled him more than taking care of and providing for them. He was infinitely proud of every member and took pride in each of their achievements. A bright star has gone out, however, the power of Mark's love and light will continue to shine on.
