Lee Baldwin, age 77, of Winter Park, Florida, passed away on November 17, 2020. Lee was born on August 11, 1943, in Vernon, Alabama, the daughter of Fred and Mollie (Thomas) Rolling.

Lee grew up in Birmingham, AL and graduated from Shades Valley High School. She attended Auburn University and was a member of the Pi Beta Phi sorority. She earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Education and started her teaching career in Birmingham, AL. She moved and settled in Oviedo, Florida in 1972 where she was a teacher at Lawton Elementary for a few years before becoming a full-time mom.
