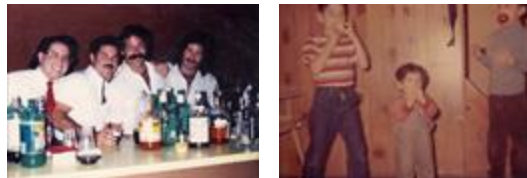

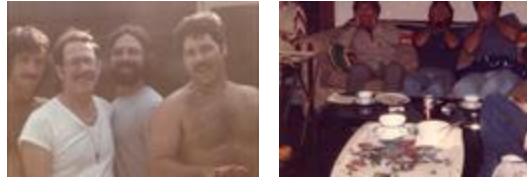

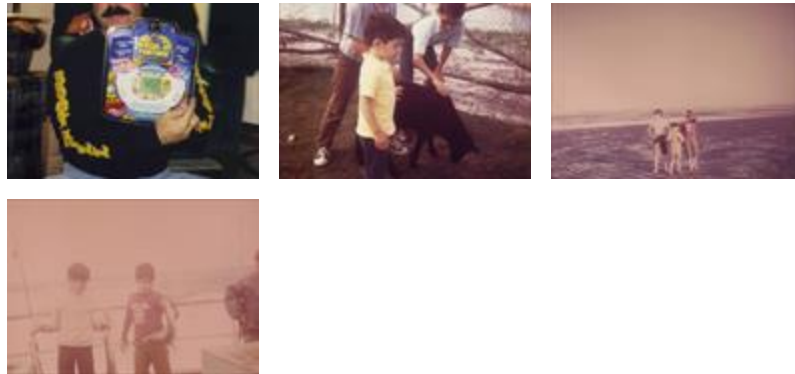

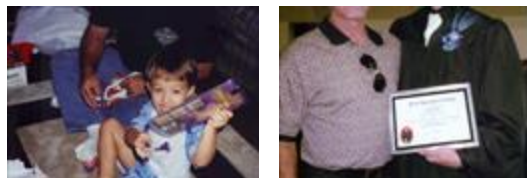

“ Here's a little story about the day Michael SAVED MY LIFE... 19 years ago on April 22, 1996 - I had a serious accident while I was removing multiple 1/4" thick, 3' x 4' mirrors from my weight rooms because I had sold my house and needed to be out in 2 weeks. Well, the bottom of one of the mirrors hit the cement step that I was stepping down into my porch with the mirror. The mirror split in half and one half fell right across my right wrist - severing 9 tendons & 2 nerves.

It was much worse than I thought. LUCKILY for me - Michael lived 4 doors down the street. I called Michael and he ran his fastest 100 yard dash to get to my place to call 911, apply pressure on my arm, and wait for the EMTs to arrive. YUP, Michael saved my life that day. If only I had been only four doors down the road on April 9th when Mike needed help. I would have been there in a flash too.

And, I always reminded Michael - that he saved my life that day!!

Michael came through for me when I needed him.

Thanks again Michael.

You saved my life.
