Miriam Berger Patty died Oct. 5, 2010, in St. Petersburg, Florida. She was 89. No services will be held.

Miriam was born August 17, 1921, in Columbus, Ohio, to Lewis L. and Eleanor Theiss Berger. Soon after her birth, the family returned to Tampa, Florida, where she and her older sister Geraldine were raised.

Miriam was a skilled and passionate golfer all her life, competing in many club and amateur tournaments. She was a member of Forest Hills Country Club, and the Forest Hills and Tampa Women's Golf Associations.

She graduated from Hillsborough High School in Tampa in 1939 and attended the Business University of Tampa. She later went to work as a civilian for the US Army Air Force at Mac Dill Field and served in the Alaskan Theatre during World War II.

Miriam met Walter L. Patty of Colorado while in Alaska and they were married in Tampa on April 3, 1944. Miriam and Walter had two children, Michael and Eleanor.

Miriam worked in residential and commercial real estate sales in Colorado and Florida until her retirement.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her sister, her former husband and her long-time friend, Margaret Finney.

She is survived by son Michael of Huntley, Wyoming; daughter Eleanor R. Hamm, (Rodney) of Pueblo, Colorado; two grandchildren, Jennifer Beardsley
