DELCAMP, DR. NATALIE HILLHOUSE LOWEY, 88, of Orlando, died on Tuesday, January 31, 2012. Natalie was born in Huntington, Indiana, where she met the love of her life, Jack, in high school. She attended Purdue University in West Lafayette, IN and when Jack came home from World War II, they married and began a life together that lasted 66 years. Jack preceded Natalie in death 16 months ago. After moving to Orlando in 1960, Natalie graduated from Rollins College with a Masters Degree in Teaching and her EdD in Early Childhood Education from the University of Florida. She taught 1st grade for 25 years as well as being an adjunct professor at Rollins. Her dedication and commitment to education was shown by receiving an Excellence in Teaching Award from Rollins – named after her! Natalie personified education. Three of her children and three of her grandchildren followed her into the teaching field.

She is survived by her sister, Sally Hendricks of Indiana, six children, Natalie, Sally (Rob), John (Cindy), Rex (Joan), Noni (Richard), and Julie (Jeff).
