Nicholas Charles Blackwell, Sr. of Clermont, Florida, age 91, loving husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather, passed away on Saturday, April 24, 2021. Nick was born January 23, 1930 in Baltimore, Maryland.

He moved to Orlando, Florida in 1959, and was employed by Martin Company as a Quality Engineer for 14 years prior to going to work for Walt Disney World in 1971.
