February 23, 1922 - January 1, 2014

Norman Cohn, age 91, of Lake Mary, Florida passed away at home on Wednesday, January 1, 2014 in Lake Mary, Florida. Mr. Cohn was born February 23, 1922 in St. Louis, MO. Preceded in death by his father and mother, Irvin and Sara (Abrams) Cohn.
