Patricia Ann O'Shea Ryan passed away peacefully and surrounded by her family on August 3rd, 2010. She was born on October 21st, 1960 in Chicago, Illinois. She is survived by her husband Patrick Ryan, her daughter Danielle Ryan, her son William Ryan, her mother Carmela Thilmany and a staggering number of family and friends. Patti called many places home but primarily lived in Chicago, IL; Bangkok, Thailand; Orlando, FL; and Williamstown, MA. 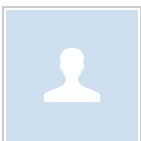

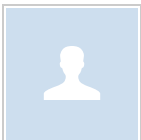

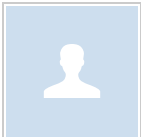
