Primo Pacy died at his home surrounded by loved ones on June 11, 2025, in Winter Springs, FL, at the age of 92.

He eventually moved to Oviedo, FL to work for Siemens. He tried to retire when he was 80 years old, but they kept calling him back!

He was proud of his children and the closeness of his entire family. Primo will be missed by all those who knew him and we sympathize with those who will never get the chance to meet him
