August 26, 1935 - January 31, 2018

Raymond Arthur Heffernan, 82, Maitland, FL passed away on 1/31/2018 from complications of Parkinson's disease. Ray was born in Brooklyn, NY on August 26, 1935 to Cornelius & Margaret (McCarthy) Heffernan. He served in the United States Navy for five years. He moved to the Orlando area in 1974.
