Russell Lawrence Farrar, 64, passed away in St. Petersburg, Florida on February 2, 2013. Russ was born in Bangor, Maine the son of Gerald and Madeline Farrar. He graduated from John Bapst High School in the class of 1967 and Eastern Maine Vocational Technical Institute in 1969. In 1969, he joined the United States Coast Guard and served as Senior Special Agent, Office of Law Enforcement. He retired in 1991 as Chief Petty Officer having completed 22 years of service. After retirement, Russ worked in the United States District Court, Bangor, Maine for five years as security officer and supervisor court security before moving to Seminole, Florida in 1994. He worked in the U.S. District Court, Middle District of Florida in Tampa under the United States Marshal Service as a court security officer, and later as intake supervisor in the United States Bankruptcy Court, Middle District of Florida. Russ is survived by his wife of 43 years Pamela (Maher) Farrar; son Eric and wife Doreen Farrar and grandchildren Kianna and Kyle Farrar; son Jason Farrar; sister Josephine (Sprague) Darling and husband Gilbert Darling; brother Thomas Farrar; and several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his brothers, David Sprague and Donald Farrar, and his sister Gertrude (Penny Farrar) O'Halloran.
