Sandra Marie Sigourney, age 72, of Longwood, Florida, passed away on May 17, 2022. Sandra was born on December 31 1949, in Saginaw, Michigan; the daughter of Julia (Brown) and Burt Schrems.

Preceded in death by her parents; Sandra is survived by her husband, Frank F. Sigourney, her sons Steven T. (Sabrina) Sigourney and Frank G.
