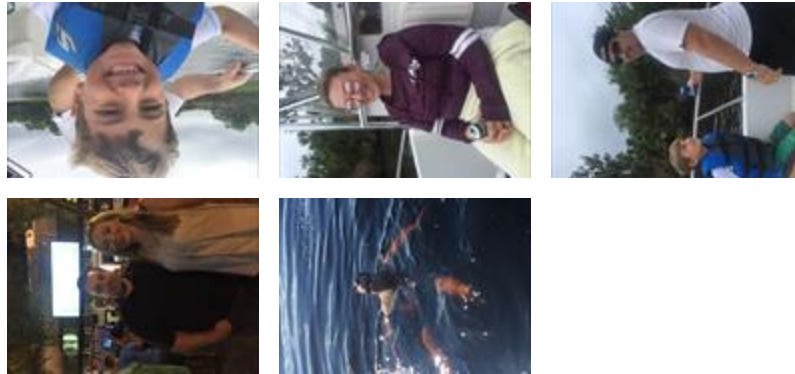
“ Steven loved many things and was always evolving but there were two constants in his life: Erin and Conner. He loved them dearly. He will be missed by many.
