



## Vicki L. Torres

Vicki Lynn Torres, 78, died at home on April 28, 2025. Throughout her 3 1/2 year battle with cancer, Vicki's personal fortitude and her faith in God never wavered.

In time, Vicki started her own company doing Human Resources Consulting.

Vicki enjoyed various hobbies throughout her life including landscape painting

and designing/crafting Christmas decorations.

Vicki believed in giving back to the community, and was always generous with her time and considerable talents. She was a member of Central Florida Spokes for many years. Vicki continued to be actively involved with Annunciation Catholic Church in Altamonte Springs, including the Saint Therese of the Little Flower Circle, and the Prayer Wheel.
