



## Dr. Wallace B. Brown Jr.

August 2, 1944 - November 24, 2015

Dr. Wallace Berline Brown Jr, 71 formally of Chattanooga Tennessee, died at home in Casselberry, Florida on November 24, 2015. He was the son of Wallace Berline Brown Sr. and Florine Jennings Brown, both now deceased. He was born August 2, 1944 in Chattanooga Tennessee, was the oldest of 10 children.
