Warren L. Norman, better known his family and friends as "Lane", passed away on Thursday, December 2nd, 2010 of cancer. He was born December 23, 1941 in High Point, NC. He settled in Florida and as a boy of 14 he knew he wanted to serve, when he became interested in Ambulances and helping those in need. He had two major goals: to become a Marine and at some point to serve in law enforcement. Lane was able to reach both, serving as a United States Marine, and as a Captain with the Orange County Sheriff's Department for 33 years. He retired and lived with Megan in Errol Estate Golf and Country Club. He is survived by his loving wife, Megan Norman and faithful friend and dog Bogey, his mother Gladys Harper and his brother Gary Norman. Others survived are Jim and Mary Couch, loving in-laws of Lane, as well as many other family members and friends.

A celebration of his life will be held on Saturday, December 11, 2010 at Journey Christian Church, 1965 South Orange Blossom Trail, Apopka, FL 32703 at 3:00 p.m., with a reception, including remembrances of his life to follow on the grounds of Journey Christian Church.

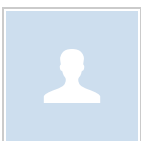

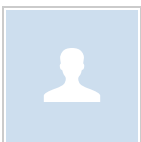

I was closest to him as a very young man, not having the opportunity to spend time with him as an adult, but as I read what those that knew him best as an adult have said about him, I am not surprised. He grew up to be the fine man that I knew he would be. His departure leaves a hole here, but adds to the host in heaven, so we will have to wait our turn to see him again.

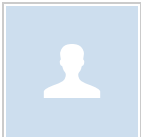
