William was baptized at Arnold Palmer Hospital when he was two days old and even though he never attended church, he was very much a part of his communities of faith. William received an overwhelming amount of love and support from so many different groups of people. We know that he was loved and cared for. William passed away on October 21, 2016. The end of his life is both unexpected and devastating, but through it we celebrate his resurrection and new life in Christ.
