William "Bill" Anthony Pfingsten, 75, of Sanford, Florida passed into heaven on August 15, 2021. Bill was born in Canton, Ohio, the son of William and Ann (Klus) Pfingsten. He attended Lower Elementary School and East Palestine Jr./Sr. High School, graduating in 1964.
